

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Religions are called to be a part of the solution for world peace, rather than contributing to be part of the conflict. The two largest religions on the planet bear a significant responsibility in this endeavor. Therefore, fostering mutual understanding between Christianity and Islam is essential, leading to mutual appreciation collaboration. SEMINAR METHODOLOGY
